



Make an Impact with Your Donor Advised Fund

A donor advised fund (or DAF) is a wonderful way for you to distribute gifts to numerous charities. With a DAF you can make gifts to charity during your lifetime and when you pass away, your children can carry on your legacy of giving.

What is a donor advised fund?

A donor advised fund is like a charitable investment account for the sole purpose of supporting charitable organizations you care about. When you contribute cash, securities or other assets to a donor advised fund at a community foundation or financial institutions like Schwab Charitable or Fidelity Charitable, you are generally eligible to take an immediate tax deduction.

How does a donor advised fund work?

Donors can make an irrevocable, tax-deductible contribution of cash, long-term appreciated securities or other assets to an organization that sponsors a DAF program, which then establishes an account in the donor's name. DAF donors may choose from a variety of investment options and proceeds are put into an account from which donors may make grant recommendations.

Can I make a contribution to the John Austin Cheley Foundation through my donor advised fund?

Yes! The John Austin Cheley Foundation is not a private foundation and is a 501 (c) (3) tax-exempt public charity. That means that you can directly impact the kids we serve through a gift from your donor advised fund. Let us know if your professional advisor needs an IRS determination letter before making your gift to JACF. We would be more than happy to provide you with one.

Don't forget to let us know! Sometimes when you make a gift through your donor advised fund, we don't always know that the gift is coming from you.
